High Point Owner/Handler entered must be the owner and horse as stated above on this form. OWNER/HANDLER or HORSE may NOT be changed throughout the competition. The nominated horse MUST be owned by the handler, as per MHF Inc. registry rules, throughout the competition.

Must stipulate only 3 performance sections from which points will be accumulated

YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP/PERFORMANCE – EACH SECTION \$16.50

- **YOUNG STOCK**– 1 year– (actual age) up to 3 years (actual age) **Halter, Performance** (Junior Trail, Command Response, Precision Cones, Junior Lunge Line (walk and trot only)
- **YOUNG ADULT**– 3 years (actual age) up to 4 years (actual age) **Halter** classes, **Performance** Hunter, Lunge-Line, Trail, **Driving** – Harness and Long Reining
- **MATURE ADULT** – 4 Years (actual age) and over – **Halter** classes, **Jumping, Performance** (Hunter, Trail, Lunge-Line) **Driving** (Obstacle, Precision and Long Reining)

TOP FIVE (three)

NATIONAL HIGH POINT VETERAN AWARD – To be awarded to the veteran horse ten years or over of any gender, either Miniature Horse or Category A Horse, with the highest total points gained in one year.

NATIONAL HIGH POINT HALTER GELDING – Awarded to the gelding any age, either Miniature Horse or Category A horse, with the highest points in halter.

NATIONAL HIGH POINT PERFORMANCE GELDING – Awarded to the gelding any age, either Miniature Horse or Category A Horse, with the highest points in performance.

RULES:

- All High Point Horses entered **MUST** be registered with MINIATURE HORSE FEDERATION Inc. and **MUST** be owned by financial members of MINIATURE HORSE FEDERATION Inc. for the duration of the competition.
- All High Point Handlers entered **MUST** be financial members of MINIATURE HORSE FEDERATION Inc. and **MUST** compete with horses registered with MINIATURE HORSE FEDERATION Inc. for the duration of the competition.
- Competition runs from **1st August to following 31st July** of any given year.
- For STATE AND NATIONAL High Point competition points may be gained interstate. State and National High Point competition must be entered separately. A horse originally entered in State High Points for one State that is sold to another State, will keep it's points and can add it's points gained from any other state **BUT** the horse must stay entered in the original State's High Points for the year.
- Point score sheets will be supplied for each horse/handler entered. Score sheets **MUST** be signed on the day of competition by the judge, or ring steward, officiating.
- Point score sheets to be sent by post (post date marked), or email by **1st of each month AFTER date of last show attended in preceding month**. e.g. last show attend in January the 30th, Point score sheet to be sent **1st February** or if a weekend, next week day.
- **Young Stock Horse** is a horse less than 36 months of age. **N.B.** When entering sections the age group the horse will fall into during the High Point competition should be considered, as a horse may not change age group sections during the competition. Horses can only compete in disciplines for which they are eligible by age.
- **Young Adult Horse** is a horse 36 months of age to 48 months of age.
- **Adult Horse** is a horse 48 months of age and over.
- Horses entered in High Point **SECTIONS**, (excluding Owner/Handler), may be shown by different handlers throughout the competition.
- High Point **OWNER/HANDLER** entered must stipulate both OWNER/HANDLER and HORSE. OWNER/HANDLER or HORSE may **NOT** be changed throughout the competition, the nominated horse **MUST** be owned by the handler, as per Federation registry rules throughout the competition.
- Horses entered in High Point **OWNER/HANDLER and** other High Point sections may be shown by different handlers for points in **ALL** sections, **BUT MUST** be shown by stipulated OWNER/HANDLER for points in **OWNER/HANDLER** section.
- High Point Horse that is sold may have points gained before sale transferred to new owner, but new owner **MUST** be a financial member of MINIATURE HORSE FEDERATION Inc., and horse **MUST** be transferred with MINIATURE HORSE FEDERATION Inc. into new owners name.
- High Point Horse under 36 months of age may transfer between Miniature Horse & Category A Horse classes, if required to comply with Federation height for age rules, points gained **BEFORE** transfer **MAY** be transferred.
- High Point Horse 36 months of age and over may transfer between Miniature Horse & Category A Horse classes, if required to comply with Federation height for age rules, **BUT** points gained **BEFORE** transfer **MAY NOT** be transferred.
- High Point Horse that attain 36 months of age during competition may transfer between Miniature Horse & Category A Horse classes, if required to comply with Federation height for age rules, but only points gained **BEFORE** transfer, **BEFORE** attaining 36 months of age may be transferred.
- Colts/Stallions that are gelded during the competition **MAY** transfer points gained as a Colt/Stallion.
- Youth Handler age is to be determined by date of birth closest to 1st August e.g. for 2009 High Point Competition (which runs from 31st July 2008 to 1st August 2009) a youth born 1st December 2000 would be entered in 8 and under. The High Point coordinator will be happy to assist with the correct age group to be entered.
- At each show Youth Handler may chose to use a different horse in Performance than the one they used in Halter. But horses may not be changed within the various performances.
- Points gained in youth Showmanship/Performance **must NOT** be used for individual horse high points
- In open shows points will not be recognized for horses competing in performances that are seen to be ineligible for that age group according to MHF Inc. rules.
